The EGGER Group headquartered in St. Johann in Tirol ranks among the world's leading wood-based material manufacturers. The family business, which was founded in 1961, now manufactures in 22 locations in 11 countries worldwide and has more than 11,000 employees. Customers include the furniture industry, wood distribution, building markets and the DIY business. Sustainable management is at the core of EGGER's corporate DNA. And this has been the case ever since the company was founded, because even back then, wood was far too valuable for Fritz Egger Sr. to simply throw it away. In the 2022/2023 financial year, the Group achieved a consolidated turnover of around EUR 4.45 billion and produced 9.6 million m³ of wood-based materials and timber.
